Direct Terramation

\$5,950

Includes the basic services of the funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to the funeral home, preparation of remains, disposition of remains through the process of terramation (Natural Organic Reduction), packaging and pick up of soil at our Auburn facility, shipping of a small bag of terramated remains to any US address, delivery of all or excess remains to the Return Home Woodland, state taxes, online tracking of process, and online memorial.

Terramation with Laying-in Service

Includes the basic services of a funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to the funeral home, preparation of remains, use of Return Home facilities for a laying-in ceremony (2 hours), disposition of remains through the process of terramation (Natural Organic Reduction), packaging and pick up of soil at our Auburn facility, shipping of a small bag of terramated remains to any US address, delivery of all or excess remains to the Return Home Woodland, state taxes, online tracking of process, online memorial.

Witness Terramation \$1,000

A Witness Terramation offers families a private and meaningful opportunity to say goodbye to their loved one prior to the terramation process. This 1-hour gathering allows loved ones to spend time together in an intimate setting with their person before the beginning of the natural organic reduction. This service does not include witnessing organics placement or witness vessel placement. Includes optional live-streaming.

Laying-in Ceremony \$2,000

A Laying-In Ceremony offers families a full service experience centered around witnessing and honoring their loved one at Return Home. This 2-hour service includes an additional 30 minutes prior for setup and 30 minutes following for breakdown, along with video recording and livestream capabilities. Families may gather around their loved one in their vessel on a bed of straw and alfalfa in a deeply personal and meaningful environment. Includes optional live-streaming and/or video tribute. Includes optional organics and vessel placement participation. Officiant services and catering are available at an additional cost.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff \$1,475

Our services include: conducting the arrangement conference; planning the funeral; consulting with family; shelter of remains; preparing and filing of necessary notices, such as to the county or state; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select (already included in our Terramation packages).

- Specialized: \$350 (up to 25 handheld/small/medium bags, rest large)
- Ultra-Specialized: \$650 (up to 50 handheld/small/medium bags)
- Extra Bags : \$100 (up to 50 total bags for self-packaging of remains)

Remains Forwarding Policy

Return Home does not ship non-reduced human remains by air at this time. We will, however, recommend other funeral homes who can provide this service.

At this time, Return Home can only ship terramated remains via USPS within the United States and Canada. We can ship the full quantity home domestically.

The following disclosures are required by the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) Funeral Rule;

FTC Funeral Rule Required Embalming Disclosure

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Clarification from Return Home

Return Home's Terramation process cannot be performed on embalmed bodies at this time. If you are sure that the body will be embalmed, you will need to utilize an alternative method of final disposition.
